#### 2007 Cuvee del Molino Blanco

La Mancha, Spain

*Really fresh, really clean, lightly dry Spanish white, offering an easy yet appealing fruit flavours. Suitable for vegetarians.*

#### 2007 Alameda, Sauvignon Blanc

Central Valley, Chile

*Powerfully aromatic and nettly in style, with a core of ripe passionfruit, this is a benchmark new world Sauvignon.*

#### 2007 Via Fordulo, Pinot Grigio

Gloucestershire, England

*A delicious, easy drinking dry white wine that owes so much to the inclusion of the Phoenix varietal*

### Red Wines

#### 2007 Vinas Riojanas Cabernet, 'Seleccion',

Famatina Valley, Argentina

*This exhibits a powerful smoky nose of black fruits, followed by a full-bodied & rich palate, with fine balancing tannins and a smooth velvety finish.*

#### 2007 Cuvee del Molino Tinto, Tempranillo

La Mancha, Spain

*Smooth, well rounded Tempranillo with a hint of gentle spice. A great introduction to present day Spanish reds*

#### 2006 Alameda, Merlot

Morande Maipo Valley, Chile

*Cherries and plums abound on the nose. The palate is rich, and ripe tannins frame the elegant finish.*

#### 2007 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 'Ca de Mori'

Carlo Botter, Abruzzo, Italy

*Deep purple coloured, with rich aromas of black fruits, cherries and spice, the palate is supple and warming, with very gentle tannins and a refreshing finish.*

#### 2006 Karoola Ridge, Shiraz/Cabernet

South Australia

*Wonderfully ripe pure fruit yet is an beautifully elegant bottle of Aussie shiraz/cabernet.*

#### 2005 Domaine Le Cazal 'Cuvée Tradition'

Minervois, France

*Ripe, deliciously easy 'laid-back' fruit. Packed with the flavour of mixed spicy red berries.*
